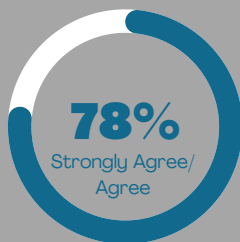


Annual SURVEY 2022



Respondents included a wide range of job roles, districts and Fams events attended.

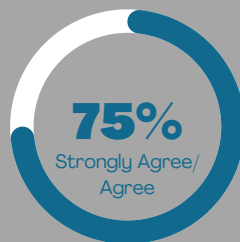
ADVOCACY

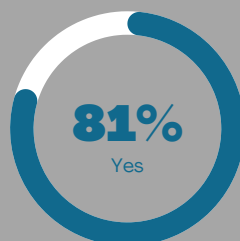
OPINION
